

TABOND 3045 ADHESIVE RESIN

TABOND 3045 is LLDPE modified with maleic anhydride functional groups which promote bonding with different materials like polar polymers, metals and surface treated glass.

Characteristics:

- Strong adhesion to aminosilane treated glass, Nylon, EVOH, PET, PBT, PC, aluminium, copper, brass and steel.
- Adhesion durability
- Polyolefin like properties and processing

Applications:

- Tube co-extrusion - PE with PA or EVAL
- Blow moulding co-extrusion - PE with PA or EVOH
- Sheet co-extrusion - PE with PA, EVAL, PET, PBT, PP
- Bonding agent for extrusion coating of aluminium or steel with PE (also for steel coated with epoxy resin)
- Chemical coupling agent for PE composites
- and Wire&Cable compounds containing fillers such as ATH, $MG(OH)_2$, glassfiber etc. (recommended concentration 1.5 - 5%)
- Compatibilizer for alloys of PE with PA, EVOH, PET, PP or PBT (recommended concentration 2-5%).
- Additive for recycling of polyolefin's with polar polymers.
